Reporting to the Plant Manager, this position will manage activities performed by the Health, Safety and Environment Department. The position will supervise two, or more, staff and will coordinate and involve all levels of management, employees and contractors in compliance with the site and corporate Health, Safety and Environment Management System. Typical responsibilities of this position also include:

- Initiation and coordination of the Milner Health and Safety program compliance as directed by the Milner Health, Safety and Environment (HSE) policies and programs.
- Developing Safety and Health standards and programs to improve effective management and reduce Lost Time Accidents (LTA).
- Provide guidance to employees, ensuring that all activities meet government and industry compliance as required by Regulatory Standards and Acts.
- Develop and monitor the implementation of training and education programs for safety and environmental compliance strategies.
- Responsible for ensuring Milner is in compliance with all federal, provincial and municipal environmental regulations.
- Manage and direct Milner's Continuous Emissions Monitoring Systems (CEMS) compliance.

The ideal candidate would possess a University or Technical Diploma in either Health and Safety or Environmental or a University Degree in Science. The candidate should have at least 8 years of experience in a HSE related field and should have, or be working towards, a CRSP designation.

Applicant should also be able to demonstrate effective leadership in a team environment and have highly developed communication, problem solving, causal analysis, conflict resolution and interpersonal skills.
